4. Scholarships will be awarded at Senior Honors Night on June 4, 2019, for SLEHS or June 6, 2019, for SLHS.

PURPOSE:

This scholarship is designed to recognize a senior student from each South Lyon high school who has overcome a significant obstacle or demonstrated dramatic academic improvement during their high school experience.

CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a senior who has attended South Lyon public school for their junior and senior years.
- No minimum GPA. Applicants must be on track to graduate in June of 2019.
- Scholarship monies must be used during the 2019-2020 school year. Winners may attend any 2-year or 4-year college, trade or technical school, or a certificate program.

APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Completed application essay.
- Official or unofficial copy of your high school transcript.
- A letter of recommendation from a South Lyon Community School District staff member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for the following fall semester.
